FRAUD ACT, 2012

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of Liberia in Legislature Assembled:

SECTION 1: Chapter 15 Offenses Against Property, Subchapter D Theft and Related Offenses of the Penal Law, Title 26, Liberian Code of Laws Revised, is hereby amended to add Section 15.62 Mail Fraud and Section 15.63 Fraud by Wire, Radio and Television, as follows:

Chapter 15. OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY

Subchapter D. THEFT AND RELATED OFFENSES

§15.62. Mail fraud

1. Offense. Notwithstanding existing fraudulent crimes under the Penal Law such as the offenses of forgery and counterfeiting, facilitation of counterfeiting, obtaining or issuing deceptive writings, tampering with public documents, inter alia, with their respective penalties, a person is guilty of the specific offense of mail fraud, who, for the purpose of conducting, promoting, or carrying on by means of any postal or courier service, any scheme or device or any other unlawful business, uses or assumes, or requests to be addressed by, any fictitious, false, or assumed title, name, or address or name other than his own proper name, or takes or receives from any post office or authorized depository of mail matter, any letter, postal card, package, or other mail matter addressed to any such fictitious, false, or assumed title, name, or address, or name other than his own proper name. Such fraud is a predicate offense to money laundering and terrorist financing.

2. Grading. The offense of mail fraud shall be punishable as a first degree felony.

§15.63. Fraud by wire, radio, television or other electronic communication

1. Offense. Notwithstanding existing fraudulent crimes under the Penal Law such as the offenses of forgery and counterfeiting, facilitation of counterfeiting, obtaining or issuing deceptive writings, tampering with public documents, inter alia, with their respective penalties, a person, having devised or intending to devise any scheme or artifice to defraud, or for obtaining money or property by means of false or fraudulent pretenses, representations, or promises, transmits or causes to be transmitted by means of wire, radio, or television or other communication in local commerce such as internet, any writings, signs, signals, pictures, or sounds for the purpose of executing such scheme or artifice including money laundering and terrorist financing, shall be guilty of the offense of fraud by wire, radio, television or other electronic communication. Such fraud is also a predicate offense to money laundering and terrorist financing.

	2. Grading. The offense of fraud by wire, radio or television shall be punishable as a first degree felony.
	SECTION 2 : This Act shall take effect immediately upon publication in Handbillsby the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
